Learning Through Play (and how to continue the play at home)

Happy Fall, Spring-Mar! Through the years, one of the main reasons families have chosen our school is for our learning through play philosophy and child-focused experience. In fact, play-based learning is not only for the young, we can all benefit from more play! Our staff strives to provide opportunities for your kids to explore, be creative, and frequently ask "What if?" You can easily extend and recreate these lessons in your home.

Recently during Open Centers, we set up a process art area which I like to call "Paint with anything but a paintbrush." We used natural materials (flowers and leaves), recyclable materials (toilet paper rolls and plastic bottles), and things you probably have around the house (cotton balls and sponges).

If you aren't quite ready to embrace the mess, take your art and play outside. Set up a mud kitchen in your backyard with old pots and utensils. Use chalk and a spray bottle to turn a driveway or sidewalk into an area for games and sensory play. Spray bottles are also great for increasing fine motor skills! Inclement Weather Policy

In case of any needed weather or emergency closings, delays, or early dismissals, an All-School Email will be sent out to inform you.

If Fairfax County Public Schools:

- Dismiss early: Pick up your child as soon as possible. Check your email for the most accurate information.
 Staff will stay with students until all parents arrive. If you cannot arrive before 12:15 p.m., call the school with your estimated arrival time.
- Are closed: Spring-Mar is closed.

If at the discretion of the President and/or Director, conditions warrant the closing of Spring-Mar, even though the Fairfax County Public Schools have not closed, an All-School email will be sent out.


